CASA is a national volunteer movement that began in the late 1970s in Seattle. Its purpose is to find community volunteers to act as a "voice in court" for abused and neglected children. The first CASA program was established in Dallas in 1980. In Texas, there are 72 local CASA programs with 10,856 volunteers serving 30,136 foster children. Lone Star CASA, Inc. advocates for children in Rockwall and Kaufman Counties.

Cars for CASA, which is put on annually by more than 40 volunteers, has grown to become one of the most successful auto shows in North Texas. The first event in 2005 featured 80 cars and raised \$2,600. This year's show is expected to feature more than 400 cars and raise more than \$100,000 for Lone Star CASA. To date the show has raised more than \$910,000 for Lone Star CASA. To date the show has raised more than \$910,000 for Lone Star CASA!!! As we prepare for our **20th Year** of our Cars for CASA event, we are deeply grateful for the ongoing support of our sponsors. Your sponsorship helps our volunteers to advocate for children who have experienced abuse and neglect in our community to find support, care, and stability.

Last year, a mom battled methamphetamine and heroin usage during pregnancy due to associating with the child's father and exposing herself to unhealthy people. When baby Landon was born, CPS removed him and brought him into CPS care. Mom was able to complete a detox program and then enrolled in a year long inpatient treatment program. Due to the progress, she had made, CASA advocated for the judge to place the Landon back with his mom along with a range of services. Landon's mom did not trust CASA initially because she equated CASA with CPS. But CASA supported and encouraged her. The CASA volunteer's experience as a pediatric nurse provided Landon's mom with the reassurance she needed to open up about her anxieties and fears about parenthood. The volunteer attended hearings and reported to the judge in the case about the mom's progress and dedication to Landon. CASA's non-judgmental and supportive approach provided Landon's mom with a platform to take autonomy over her life. She was able to enhance her life skills, financial sustainability, parenting skills, and counseling accountability. She did not look back at her past but looked forward to her future where she could provide a healthy, stable, and drug-free life for Landon.

Because of donors like you, Lone Star CASA can continue to build relationships and advocate for children experiencing abuse and neglect in your community. In 2024, Lone Star CASA:

- advocated for 214 children in Rockwall and Kaufman and counties.
- helped 88 of these children achieve permanency when their cases were closed.
- traveled over 64,000 miles serving the kids in our care.

Too many children in the child welfare system lose their families, their rights and their hope.

Join our fight to make sure they don't!

We see news stories every day about children taken from an abusive home, or because of the tragic loss of a parent—to illness or violence or incarceration. We assume there must be a program or system that will take care of these children and make sure they are treated with dignity, given a safe place to live, so they can recover from their hardship and be a child again.

But there is a story behind the story that few people speak about. It is the story of overburdened foster care and child welfare systems that—though full of well-intentioned and deeply committed people—cannot begin to meet the needs of the more than 660,000 children in foster care in the United States.

It is a story that occurs over and over again in America's foster care and child welfare system.





But these stories can have better endings, because there is a group of trained volunteers, appointed by judges to advocate for these children. People who fight for these abused and neglected children, to make sure their basic rights and essential needs don't get overlooked or ignored by the system. These stories can have better endings because of people like you.

We are Court Appointed Special Advocates

(CASA) for Children, a volunteer-powered network of committed people—from all walks of life—who believe society has a fundamental obligation to these children. We are people just like you who believe that every child has the right to be treated with dignity, to be safe, and to thrive in the embrace of a loving family.

With a CASA volunteer, a child is half as likely to languish in the foster care and child welfare system, and that much more likely to find a safe, permanent home.
