Constitutional Amendments on November Special Election Ballot

Nov. 4 is a big day on the government affairs front, as Texas voters take to the polls in the for 2025's Constitutional Amendments Special Election Day. The amendments earned enough votes in the legislature to be placed on the ballot for voter approval in order to become law.

Multiple propositions earned the support of our industry, including Proposition 1, which ensures Texas State Technical College (TSTC) has sufficient funds to expand job-training programs by authorizing two funds to expand classrooms and facilities, modernize labs and train more students to meet the challenges of today's economy.

Other propositions that have the home building industry's support:

Proposition 2 - SJR 18 "The constitutional amendment prohibiting the imposition of a tax on the realized or unrealized capital gains of an individual, family, estate, or trust."

Proposition 4 - HJR 7 "The constitutional amendment to dedicate a portion of the revenue derived from state sales and use taxes to the Texas water fund and to provide for the allocation and use of that revenue."

Proposition 8 - HJR 2 "The constitutional amendment to prohibit the legislature from imposing death taxes applicable to a decedent's property or the transfer of an estate, inheritance, legacy, succession, or gift."

Proposition 9 - HJR 1 "The constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation a portion of the market value of tangible personal property a person owns that is held or used for the production of income."

Proposition 10 - SJR 84 "The constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature to provide for a temporary exemption from ad valorem taxation of the appraised value of an improvement to a residence homestead that is completely destroyed by a fire."

Proposition 11 - SJR 85 "The constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to increase the amount of the exemption from ad valorem taxation by a school district of the market value of the residence homestead of a person who is elderly or disabled."

Proposition 13 - SJR 2 "The constitutional amendment to increase the amount of the exemption of residence homesteads from ad valorem taxation by a school district from \$100,000 to \$140,000."

Proposition 17 - HJR 34 "The constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature to provide for an exemption from ad valorem taxation of the amount of the market value of real property located in a county that borders the United Mexican States that arises from the installation or construction on the property of border security infrastructure and related improvements."

Dallas BA Participates in Legislator's Panel on Special Districts

On Oct. 27, Dallas BA's Director of Government Affairs David Lehde took part in a panel organized by Texas State Representative Keith Bell that served to inform local elected officials and decision makers on the nuances of special districts in Texas, as well as discuss apprehensions some may have.

Texas' rapid growth demands a steady supply of attainable housing and quality infrastructure. Special districts are crucial tools developers can use to help provide essential services and allow growth to pay for itself. Lehde explained how that is a benefit in areas that may wish to see the new development funded by the people who live in the new community.

He also explained how, due to districts being subject to oversight, that the community gets the value of high-quality infrastructure where the risk is put on the developer and not the taxpayers, while the transparency in the districts' governance helps assure accountability and local control.

Special districts are reimbursement models where the developer gets paid back only after delivering on what they say they are going to do. It is a sustainable financing model that provides for more attainable housing.

Lehde also stressed the importance of the local government entity, and the developer or builder communicating their needs and concerns early on in the process. When the

HOMEPAC of Greater Dallas provides another opportunity for Association members to participate in the Association's advocacy efforts.



"Through dedicated mentorship, we aim to inspire innovation, uphold integrityand build a strong foundation for the future of the building industry."


